

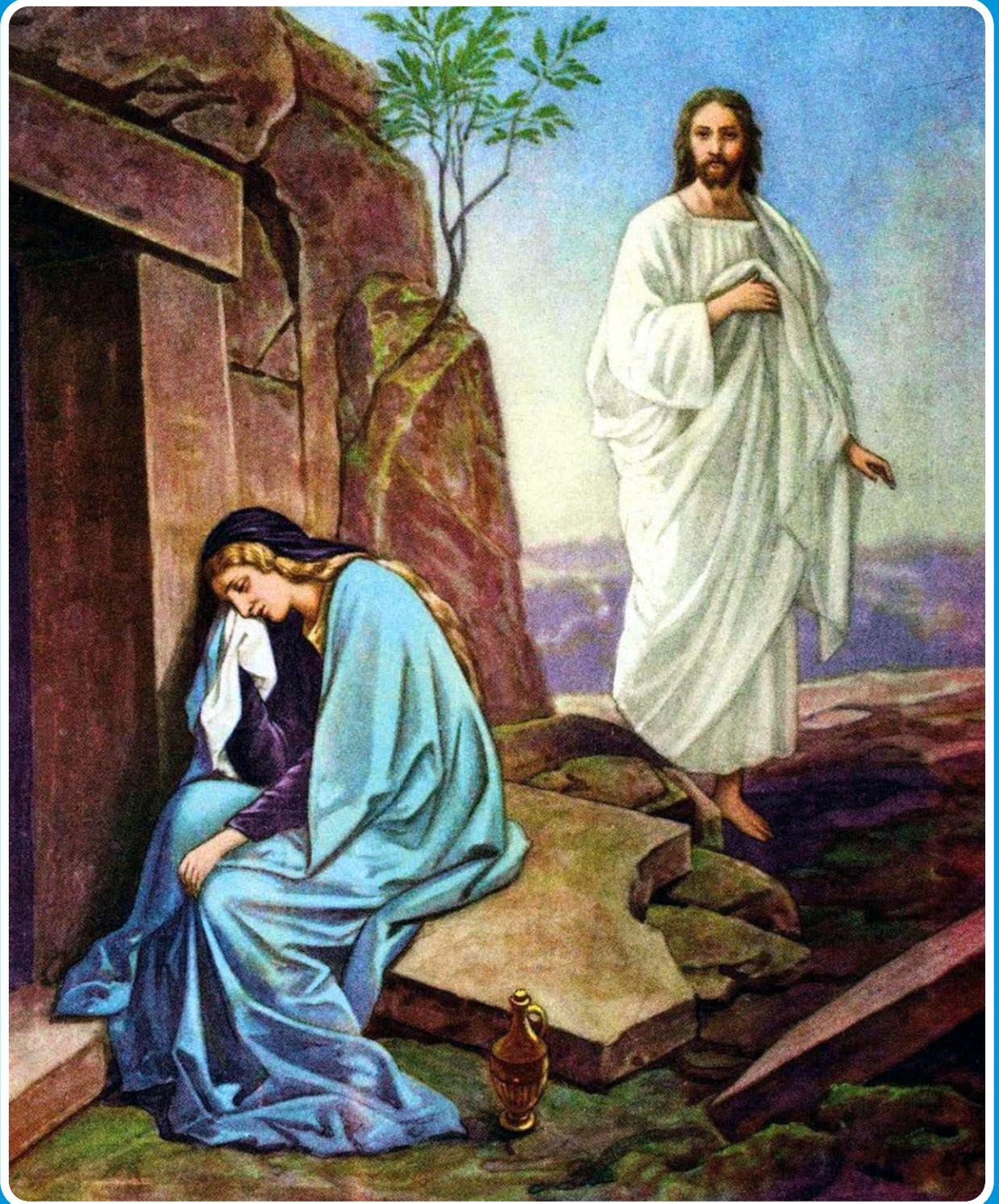

# Pre-baptism .....an enriching and fulfilling experience!!

We Praise and thank the Lord for the Pre-bap ministry, which has always been very close to our hearts, as it was the very first ministry we started way back in 2009, when we shifted from Bandra to Nerul. It has helped us grow spiritually as we share our faith experiences with the expecting couples.

The Pre-bap sessions were held for 3 couples with godparents on 13th, 14th, 20th and 21st January 2024. These sessions have been held in our Parish on a regular basis for the past few years. Announcements are made well in advance so that all parishioners are aware that this is mandatory for all couples who wish that their child be baptized and it is advisable that they can do it as early as the 3rd month of pregnancy.

The Pre-bap sessions are divided into four and are held on two weekends. , The duration of each session is about 90mins.

Following are the topics:

1) Growing in Love. 2) Living our Baptismal promises. 3) Witnessing to our children 4) Baptism - The first sacrament of Initiation.

Each of the sessions are very interactive and emphasize the need to give the couples their role and responsibility as parents and godparents to bring up their child in Christian faith. It is mandatory for godparents to attend only the last session. The role and responsibility of godparents in the journey of faith formation of the child is

well explained to understand the significance.

The feedback of most of the couples in the past has been very positive and we would encourage more couples to join as animators and be part of this wonderful and fruitful ministry.



## World Marriage Day Celebration

This year we celebrated World Marriage Day in our parish on 11th Feb 2024, during the 9.30 am Eucharist. It was concelebrated By Fr. Sebastian and Fr. Prem. A beautiful homily was given by Fr. # GROWING IN HOLINESS - LENTEN RECOLLECTION

During Lent, we exercise the spiritual muscles to become what God wishes for us, and that begins with desiring to desire God. The theme of this years' Lenten Recollection was "Growing in Holiness" led by Br George Pereira from Thane.

It was held on the 2nd and 3rd March 2024, on Saturday we started with Praise and worship which was led by Melrisha and Noel with talented energetic youth of the Music Ministry, their harmonious melodies and song selection had been instrumental in creating an atmosphere of reverence and reflection.

Br George referred to 2 verses from the Old Testament and New Testament

**Leviticus 20:26:** *Thus, you are to be holy to me, for I the Lord am Holy; and I have set you apart from the peoples to be mine*

**1 Peter 1:16:** It is written *"You shall be holy, for I am holy."*

We are called to be holy and set apart from the world, attaching ourselves to God and detaching ourselves from worldly pleasures and desires. To be holy means to be set apart or separate from sin and evil. God is holy—completely separate from everything that is evil.

Br George took the example from the parable of the prodigal son.

**Luke 15:11-32. The points to be reflected from the parable...**

1) God does not always get into our way of sinful desires. He has given us free will to choose. Do we want to live a life pleasing to God or fulfil our selfish desire???(when the younger son asked for his property, the father willingly gives it to him.

- 2) Sometimes we want things before we are even ready, we force God to Give us the blessing instead of waiting, and then are not able to handle the blessing.
- 3) When we are impatient and make hasty decisions, we suffer destruction (younger son lost all his wealth in loose living)
- 4) When we do the wrong things and fall into a pit, there is no one to help us.
- 5) Repent and come back to our Loving Father just like the prodigal son did,
- 6) Our father is willing to wash us of all our sins and waits for us to return to him with a repentant heart. Our father loves us and is full of mercy.

The second day he spoke about How we can live a Holy Life??

When we plug ourselves to Jesus, we will receive power. Intimacy with God and a true desire to build a relationship with him through prayer. / Know God-Love God -Serve God / Receive the sacraments regularly / Fellowship with Church / Ministries etc./ Reading spiritual books / Watching spiritual movies.

Br. George conducted a spirit filled and anointed session of Inner Healing in which we were free of the negative emotional feelings and harmful experiences in our life. As we abide in God (**John 15:5**) He transforms our hearts and heals us.

Would like to take this opportunity to thank our Parish priest Fr. Arul and Fr. Prem for their dedication and tireless efforts in arranging this spiritually enriching recollection. Their commitment to nurturing our faith community is truly commendable.

## CHURCH CRIB CONTACT DURING CHRISTMAS SEASON

Bishop Barthol suggested few parishes in Mumbai and Navi Mumbai to conduct a 'Crib Contact' programme from 25th December 2023 to 2nd January 2024. It was advised to contact people visiting the Crib during these days, especially people of other faith. We legionaries were asked to interact with the people visiting and enlighten them about the significance of Christmas. Handouts regarding the same were distributed so that they could learn about 'The Christmas Story'. OUR LADY OF VISITATION the English and OUR LADY OF GOOD COUNSEL Tamil Prasedium of "Our Lady of Visitation Church" were a part of this programme. We made contact with approximately 100 catholic adults and children and 250 adults and children of other faith.

Our feelings at the crib mirrored the responses of the people visiting the crib. Awe, reverence, devotion, curiosity, faith, peace, hope and a mental visualization of what must have transpired at the birth of Lord Jesus. The crib attracted people of all religions and it was evident that many had deep faith in Jesus. On Christmas day especially many of them spent time devotedly praying inside the church after

a visit to the crib. We enjoyed sharing our faith by evangelizing and telling people about Jesus and the true sentiments of Christmas. A woman also asked for a pocket Bible to help her daughter and her to know more about Jesus. It was provided to her. The children and the elders of other faith felt they came to know more about Christmas by interacting with us. In fact it was even a learning experience for all of us too as we answered the questions posed by the visitors.

Some shared with us the reasons as to why they visit the Crib regularly at Christmas. Among these the one that stood out was when a person of other faith told us she had become a believer in Jesus after she was cured of a long drawn illness after she prayed in total faith to Jesus. Another family that resided in Germany missed seeing such a beautiful large crib at a church and especially the young girl who was amazed and in awe at the sight of the crib. Many took family photographs at the crib as a memory of their visit.

# Lenten Pilgrimage to Karjat

This was the 2nd year that I participated with our Parish group to relive the last moments of Jesus at the experiential Way of the Cross at Don Bosco, Karjat. I prepared myself to carry the Cross and wear the crown of nails after the 14th station till the Resurrection scene. Since there was another group at the next station, we had to wait for our turn for a little while. As the crown of nails was placed on my head, instantly I could feel its weight concentrated at the tips of the nails. The constant, dull pain from the crown of nails seemed to blank out the hymns being sung by our group as we waited for our turn to climb up to the Resurrection scene and I had my recollection during those few minutes.

I realized that during Lent very often I await Easter to end my abstinence. What did Jesus do after he rose from the dead? What were his followers going through after Jesus died? His disciples were frightened and full of doubt. Jesus appeared to them several times over the next 40 days after his Resurrection; he taught and ministered to them. He gave them

three crucial messages which are meant for all of us as well.

(1) His Resurrection was real. He had defeated death and we are all inheritors of this gift. All of us believers are raised to new life in this world and to everlasting life in the world to come.

(2) His atonement for all our sins was complete and it is now possible for us to fully partake of its blessings. The mass is a celebration and during the Consecration the Bread and Wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus which He gave up for our sins. The mystery of faith we sing right after is our declaration of our faith and communion with Jesus.

(3) Finally, Jesus exhorts us to go and spread the Good News and make disciples of men. He also promised that after his Ascension, he would send a Helper, the Holy Spirit, who will dwell in us and empower us to bear witness to Jesus Christ and spread his Good News to all.

I encourage everyone to experience the Way of the Cross at Don Bosco, Karjat at least once and have your personal experience of Walking with Our Lord.

# Activities - Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVP) at OLVC

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVP) is an international church organization having its conferences all over the world. The Conference of Our Lady of the Visitation in our parish has its roots from 2007.

Ever since then, the members (currently 13) meet once a week (Sundays) to pray and assess the needs of those who approach them. As the needy apply for aid, the members visit their houses for an initial investigation to assess the genuine need. Then it is recommended to the Conference during the meeting. The members collectively decide to reach out or not as per need. Thus, the adopted families are then provided with ration aid, education aid, and medical aid accordingly.

Apart from the above-mentioned, the Conference also collects clothes (old and new), toys, stationery items, etc., and distributes them among the needy which includes children, students, men and women who are in dire need.

The members also visit two Homes run by the SVP, Niramay Niketan, a Hospice for the HIV/AIDS cum Leprosy patients at Trombay and Shanti Bhavan, Home for the Aged at Kalyan giving them a helping hand as and when required.

The Conference reaches out to the Catholics helping them have access to the sacraments. Many are helped to get some

employment to run their families.

The members attend all meetings, recollections, and retreats conducted timely by the higher units. They also reach out to the other conferences around who need help and support.

All the above-mentioned activities are possible only because of the support the parishioners provide through donations to SVP, contributions through a second collection during the holy mass (once a month), and the Secret Bag Collection the members hold during each meeting.

## **Amount Spent during the Year 2023-24:**

Here is a brief report of how we spent the money that was received till date this financial year 2023-24:

**Ration Aid given: Rs. 1,59,218/-**

**Medical Aid given: 1,24,079/-**

**Educational Aid given: 1,52,182/-**

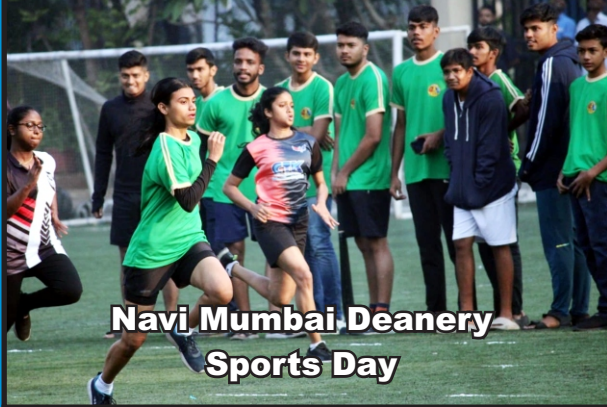
